

## HEALTH PROFESSIONAL INVESTIGATOR IN WOMEN'S HEALTH RESEARCH AWARD

The Women's Health Research Institute (WHRI) is pleased to honour practicing health professionals this year with our new **Health Professional Investigator in Women's Health Research Award**. This award will be presented at the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual WHRI Symposium on Wednesday May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018 on UBC Campus in Vancouver.

This year's WHRI award is meant to recognize research excellence in a health professional from British Columbia who is actively involved in patient care or public health practice and whose research focuses on women's or newborn health. The award will be presented to a practicing health professional who has made a significant contribution to scholarly or research endeavours in women's or newborn health research.

Candidates who conduct women's or newborn health research in any of the four research themes of CIHR (Biomedical; Clinical; Health Services; Social, Cultural, Environmental, and Population Health Research) are eligible for consideration.

Award recipients will receive a \$500 prize.

**Please note:** applicants may be self-nominated or be nominated by someone else on their behalf.

### **Eligibility**

- Member of a regulated health profession, as recognized by the BC Health Professions Act, with a valid licence to practice in BC, and a member in good standing of the appropriate regulatory college, OR belong to a health profession requiring board certification, and be a member in good standing of its respective provincial or national certification body.
- Faculty members at any research institution in British Columbia, including clinical and adjunct appointments.
- Be engaged in active service as defined by their professional scope of practice.
- Be actively and directly involved in patient care or public health practice in BC.
- Current Postdoctoral Fellows or Clinical Fellows will not be eligible.

### **Application Package**

- Cover letter (1 pages)
  - Single page cover letter that describes the research contribution made by the applicant as a health professional in active service.
- Curriculum vitae (5 pages maximum)
