# Updates from March 21 – 27<sup>th</sup>

**Research Curtailment** has been initiated across all institutions. This week the <u>BCCHR/WHRI/BCMHSUS Exemption Form</u> was launched [Attached email]. Those who submitted an exemption will be informed whether their application is approved by the end of day today. If further information is required to make a determination about an application, we will contact researchers directly for clarification. Please note that the research exemption form process will remain active, and if you believe your research may qualify for an exemption at a later time, you are still able to complete the form and have your request considered. Please note that only research which has been approved by the exemption process will be permitted to take place onsite at C&W. If your research was not approved as exempt, no one from the research team is permitted to be onsite to take part in any aspect of the research. Are you conducting or plan to conduct COVID-19 related research? The WHRI is interested in learning about any members who have received REB approval to do COVID-19 related research, as well as any WHRI members who plan to undertake COVID-19 related research. A Ministerial Order issued by the Minister of Citizen Services related to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act [Attached: FIPPA 26-Mar-2020.PDF] to support storage of data outside Canada to enable the public sector to use various cloud-based digital communications platforms during COVID-19 – this acts as a suspension of the privacy law requirement for storage in Canada while COVID-19 is a pandemic.
