About the study

We will examine your microbiome at delivery and in your baby in the first 3 months of life. Our goal is to better understand the connection between your microbiome and the development of your baby's microbiome.

Why is this research important?

Some research shows a potential link between the type of delivery (vaginal or cesarean) and a baby's gut microbiome, which may influence the risk of conditions like asthma and allergies later in life. However, we do not have all the answers. Help us learn more!
